Even for Londoners, the image of foggy London with its black taxi cab, Big Ben, a red double-decker bus, and a phone booth, is powerful and meaningful.

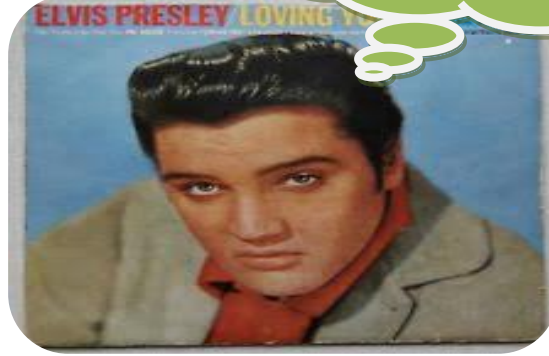

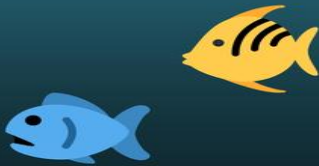

What is a black hole?

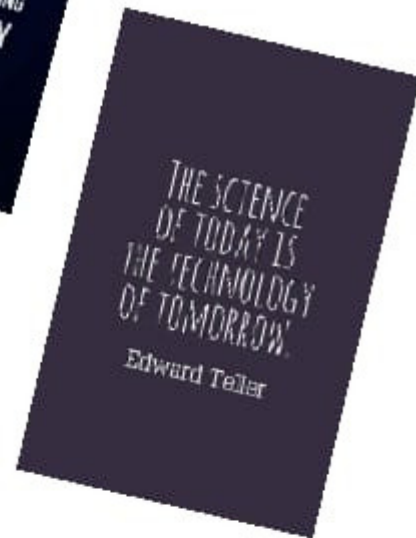

Turkish Scientists

Feryal ÖZEL

Feryal Ozel is a Professor of Astronomy and Astrophysics at the Department of Astronomy at University of Arizona. She has made pioneering contributions to the physics of neutron stars and black holes, as well as to the co-evolution of black holes and galaxies in the early Universe. Born in Istanbul, Turkey, Dr. Ozel attended the Uskudar American Academy for middle school and high school, graduating in 1992. Spending a year in Europe, she received a master's degree from Niels Bohr Institute in 1997 and worked at CERN. She received her PhD from Harvard University in astrophysics in 2002 on the effects of the intense gravitational and magnetic fields of neutron stars. She is the only Turkish female scientist working at NASA. This sentence may not be too magnificent to read, but just stop and think for a second. We are talking about a name that is the head of NASA's Space Telescope project to be realized in 2020, is included in the list of Great Ideas along with famous geniuses such as Albert Einstein and John Nash and is considered to be one of the most intelligent women in the world. Professor Feryal Özel, who graduated from Üsküdar American High School, works on the same field as Stephen Hawking, the world's greatest physicist. Now it is time to stand up and take our hats off to Özel, who represents the Turkish women rightly in NASA corridors.



Aziz SANCAR

He was born in 1946 in Savur\Mardin. He was born as the seventh of eight children of a middle income farmer family. He completed his primary, secondary and high school education in Mardin. Aziz Sancar was interested in football during his high school years, but he decided not to be a football player and he went to İstanbul for his higher education.

In 2015, he was awarded the Nobel Prize in Chemistry for his work on "Chemistry Mapping" the damaged DNA repairing the genetic information at a molecular level.

*At the end he was struggling to concentrate, had trouble with short-term memory, became paranoid, and started hallucinating. (Claudia Aguirre, TED-Ed)



What happens if you don't sleep?

1. You get sick

Losing sleep can make illness easier.



2. Your heart suffers

Both short sleep durations and long sleep durations have a negative impact on heart health, according to an analysis published in the European Heart Journal.



3. Your cancer risk increases



Shortened sleep is associated with breast cancer, colorectal cancer, and prostate cancer, according to the AASM's sleep statement.

4. You can't think

Even missing one night of sleep can cause thinking problems such as memory, decision-making, reasoning, and problem-solving worsened, along with reaction time and alertness.



5. You gain weight



A study examined 21,469 adults over the age of 20, who slept less than 5 hours each night for 3-years. They were more likely to gain weight and become obese.

6. You're accident prone



You're 3 times more likely to be involved in a car accident if you get 6 or fewer hours of sleep each night, according to the National Sleep Foundation.

How to play basketball

Bocce is played with 8 balls and 1 pallina.



How to play volleyball



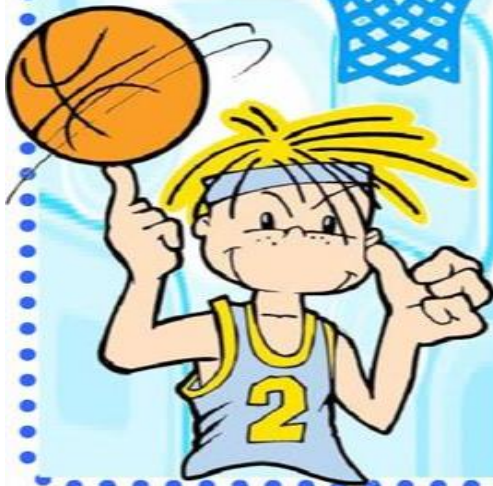
Volleyball is played by two teams with six players in each. The aim of the game is to throw the ball over the net. You can touch the ball three times. You mustn't let the ball hit the ground.

What do we need to play ?

To play this sport, you need a ball and a net.



BASKETBALL: a new game



In 1891, a Canadian sports teacher that worked in an American school in Massachusetts invented a new game. His name was James Naismith.

James decided to create a game for his lazy and rebellious students. They had to keep fit but they couldn't go outside because it was a very cold winter. They had to play in the gym.

He took two old peach baskets that he saw on the floor and put them on the wall. Then, he organized the students in two teams and he asked them to pass a big round ball and throw it into the baskets. This is how J. Naismith invented basketball.

His students loved the game and learnt the 13 rules that their teacher made. Soon it became very popular in the USA.

Today basketball is still a very popular team game. Millions of people play this sport all over the world. And there are excellent basketball players!! Can you name any?

National Sovereignty and Children's Day

National Sovereignty and Children's Day is a national holiday created by combining three other holidays. In the beginning "Children Day" was another day, and "National Sovereignty" and "April 23 Holiday" were separate holidays, they were combined as "Children Holiday".



April 23 is children day and it is related to the opening of the The Grand National Assembly; however, the opening of the GNAT was celebrated separately from children day until 1981. Children day was first celebrated in 1927.

When is National Sovereignty and Children's Day?

National Sovereignty and Children's Day is a national festival in Turkey, always celebrated on 23 April.

The holiday commemorates the first opening of the Grand National Assembly of Turkey at Ankara in 1920.

History of National Sovereignty and Children's Day

Every year, April 23 National Sovereignty and Children's Day, which Atatürk made a present

to all the world's children, is celebrated with the same enthusiasm. So, what is the story of this date,? Here is the story of April 23 National Sovereignty and Children's Day...

April 23 is the public holiday in Turkey as the GNAT was opened on the same day in 1920. With the help of Atatürk's leadership, the GNAT was opened within a short period and it started to work for the proclamation of the Republic.

On 23 April 1920, during the War of Independence, the Grand National Assembly met in Ankara to begin to lay the foundations of the new Turkish republic after the end of the Ottoman Empire.

To mark the event, 23 April was proclaimed a national holiday in 1921.

The founder of the Turkish Republic, Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, declared 23 April to the children of Turkey to recognise that children are the future of the nation. This was the known history of the April 23 National Sovereignty and Children's Day. Atatürk dedicated this day to all children of the world



Since 1927 it has also become Children's Day. In 1979, UNICEF recognised this important national day as an international event.

Authorities declared 2019 year as FUAT SEZGİN year. Who is Fuat Sezgin? Let's learn about Fuat SEZGİN

--WHERE AND WHEN WAS HE BORN????

Fuat Sezgin was born in 24th October 1924 in Bitlis. He completed his high school education in Erzurum and moved to İstanbul in 1943.

--WHICH UNIVERSITY DID HE STUDY?

He attended Istanbul University The Faculty Of Oriental Studies. He had a favourite lecturer: German Helmut Ritter. Helmut Ritter recommended him to study the Sciences of Islamic Culture.

--WHEN DID HE BECOME An ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR?

In 1954. He finished his thesis on "The Sources of Al Buhari". He proved that Al Buhari was an important scholar in Islamic Culture and that his studies relied on written sources rather than oral ones.

--WHEN DID HE BECOME A PROFESSOR?

In 1965 he wrote a doctoral thesis on Jabir Ibn Hayyam and became a professor in 1966

Fuat Sezgin wrote "The History Of Arabic Written Works". He wrote

17 volumes and died while he was writing the 18th..

--WHEN DID HE DIE?

He died on 30th June 2018 in İstanbul.

--MORE ABOUT FUAT SEZGİN:::

He won many honorary awards from many universities in Turkey and abroad. He mastered 27 languages. He deserves to be remembered as a distinguished academic person.



GÖBEKLİTEPE....

THE OLDEST TEMPLE IN THE WORLD.....OR THE FIRST????

Göbeklitepe is in South eastern Turkey,in Şanlıurfa.

It is almost 12.000 years old:the world's oldest ancient site.The discovery of Göbeklitepe can change the entire history of humanity.

Ancient people built Göbeklitepe 12.000 years ago.They created a big civilization ,lived there for 3000 years and then covered it.Göbeklitepe remained hidden for 9000 years and one day a German archeologist Klaus Schmidt discovered Göbeklitepe.It is 4000 years older than the Pyramids in Egypt.The discovery of all ancient site will last almost 150 years:::such a big civilization ahead of its time.....

UNESCO added Göbeklitepe to **WORLD HERITAGE LIST** in 2018.It is worth visiting.



THE STUDENT STABS HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER::::::

Necmettin KUYUCU was a high school teacher at Gebze Atatürk Anatolian High School.He was 45 years old:a dedicated teacher.He had three children.His students liked him a lot.One of his students stabbed him because he had discipline problems with the school management.Other teachers took him to hospital but it was too late. He died.His student was 18 years old.....AND THE TEACHER NECMETTİN KUYUCU DIED.25.000 people joined his funeral.His students said,"Every morning Mr Kuyucu tells us to be silent and stop talking but nobody stops.Today nobody told us to be silent,but we are silent ,too sorry,upset for him.

Authorities named the school he was working after him.Now it is NECMETTİN KUYUCU ANATOLIAN HIGH SCHOOL

When I was a child, I played games with my friends. Let me introduce you.

HOPSCOTCH



What you need

- chalk or masking tape
- markers for each person playing - pebble, bottle cap

Activity

Use chalk to draw a hopscotch pattern on the ground or use masking tape on the floor. Create a diagram with eight sections and number them. Each player has a marker such as a stone, bottlecap, shell, button, etc. The first player stands behind the starting line to toss his or her marker in square one. Hop over square one to square two and then continue hopping to square eight, turn around, and hop back again.

Blind man's buff



What you need

All you will need is a blindfold and enough space for some excitable children!

Activity

Choose one child to be "it", and blindfold him or her. Turn her round a few times to disorientate her a little, while the other children group themselves around her. Then let her try to tag one of the other children, who will then become "it".

Seven Towers



What you need

- A ball
- Seven stones that can be piled on top of each other
- A minimum of 2 to 4 players on each team

Activity

Set boundaries for the playing field, and pile the seven stones on top of one another in the center of the boundary area.

The first team begins by trying to knock over the stones with a ball from a particular distance. This team gets three chances from three different players to knock over the pile of stones. If they are unable to knock over the pile of stones in three tries, it becomes the other team's turn.

Leapfrogging



What you need

- At least two people - but the more the merrier.
- Open space (indoors or out - you just need to be able to fit all people into a line and leave about a meter before the line for the run-up and about 3 metres after the line to land and continue leaping).

Activity

The first child should crouch down and rest their hands on their knees. The second player runs up to the crouched child in front, placing their hands on their back and leaping over like a frog flying through the air, straddling their legs wide apart on each side. On landing, this child immediately stoops down into the frog position so that the third child has to leap over the first and second, and then adopts the crouching position for the fourth player to leap over.

Two boiled eggs

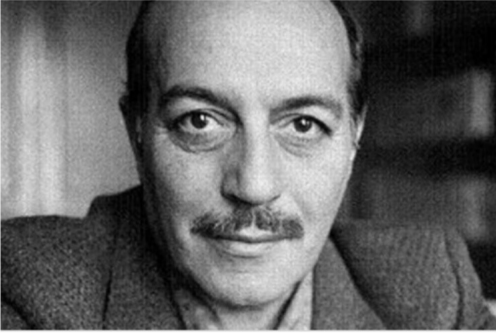
A glass of milk or yoghurt

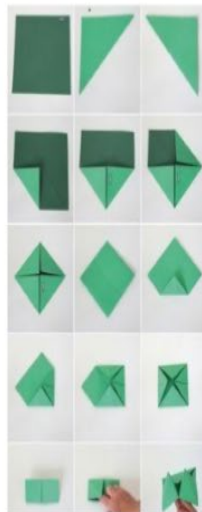
